We have all seen and heard the news reports regarding the Coronavirus fears. We are passing on some precautions which should be followed whenever you are ill with a respiratory type of sickness, whether there is an impending "outbreak" or not:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcohol based hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol) if soap and water are unavailable.
- Cover coughs with a tissue or sleeve.
- Routinely clean frequently touched surfaces.
- If temperatures are over 100.5, the child has a fever, and should stay home from school. Once the temperature is lower than 100.5 for 24 hours and the student is symptom free, they may return to school. (Please note - the office needs the fever number for reporting purposes every time you notify us of illness.)
