Are you a first time volunteer for the Heritage Restaurant? Or do you need a little refresher on the different shifts we have available to work? There's a place for everyone at the fair!

Kitchen Help: This role puts you in the kitchen helping to make food! For breakfast we have people on the grill, those scrambling eggs, assembling sandwiches, and putting together the orders. Breakfast is a great shift for "newbies" as it is a slower pace. During the lunch and dinner shift, being in the kitchen involves grilling, burger assembly, french fry station, hot dog station, and a chicken nugget station.

Pie Person: You are strictly behind the pie case for your shift, and are in charge of scooping ice cream and pie for orders.

Pop Person: Great for junior high and older. Filling all the drink orders for our servers

Take Out Runner: You'll be in the takeout window, putting the takeout orders together, getting the drinks that come with them.

Server: You're taking the orders of customers, serving them, and cashing them out. This role can seem daunting, but really it's not! It's social and fast paced if you pick a dinner shift. If you'd like to try out this role, we suggest picking a breakfast shift! This job is a great opportunity to let your light shine, as you get face to face interaction with the community!

Food Prep: Food prep in the working kitchen is just what it sounds like. You'll be helping out in the back prepping salads, filling yogurts, putting meat into roasters and supplying the working kitchen with items that they run out of.

Grandstand Workers: You'll be in the grandstands either taking orders in the window, or prepping the orders behind the counter.

Grandstand Pizza Runner: You'll be running from the pizza place (marcos) to the grandstands several time, keeping grandstands supplied.

Evening clean up: By the end of the day we have many loads of trash needed to be taken out, boxes to be broken down, and general clean up.

On every shift there are committee members there to help assist you!
