If you have questions about afternoon pick-up procedures, especially in the north parking lot, please email or call the office. If you do not normally pick up children, but plan to once in a while, you must park on the junior high end of school (north parking lot). The elementary lot is too full to safely have extra cars. Please note: anyone who picks up in the North parking lot should be parked in one of the 3 rows farthest east – this is for student safety.

Bus routes, shuttle bus information, public bus routes and transfers are still being tweaked. Please have patience with us and with the Hudsonville bus barn!

Reminder: Planned absence forms are required for all students in grades 6-8 taking any days taken off from school. Students may get one from the main office. Please also let the office know if you have children in grades K-5 leaving for a planned absence.

Directory: If you have ANY changes for the directory <u>since you filled out your enrollment form</u> please let Karen know ASAP (receptionist@hchr.org)!

All 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade teachers use Gradelink as our grading system. Log in information will be sent to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade families sometime today. All 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade families can keep up to date on your child's progress by logging in to <a href="www.gradelink.com">www.gradelink.com</a>. Please contact the office if you used Gradelink in previous years but are unable to log on this year. We can help! We will also be sending home an information sheet regarding Gradelink to all 3-8 grade families next week.

The office staff is required to have an accurate count of students at all times for safety reasons. We ask that you call or email us in the office (even if you have notified the teacher) if your child has appointments or is ill. In addition, the Health Dep't requires us to report certain symptoms to them; please let us know when you call us what your child's specific symptoms are (including how high a fever is).

School closings and delays will be communicated to all HCS families through an email. Normally decisions are made before 6:30 AM. There will not be any phone calls made; this includes bus riders. During tornado watches, the office will closely monitor local conditions. In case of a tornado warning, students will not be released until an "all clear" is issued for the area. Please don't call school or attempt to pick up students during a tornado warning

Attention: 6th- 8th graders who plan on playing a sport at Heritage during the 2025-2026 school year - You must have a sports physical form on file with the main office dated AFTER APRIL 15, 2025. If you plan to play a fall sport (cross country, volleyball, soccer) please turn your form in ASAP.
