For the innovation project, where teams must solve a real-life problem based on archeology, Team 2.0 (Emma denHartog, Kaiya Bylsma, Isla Kamminga, Milo Holstege, Jordan Koll, & Wyatt Lenting) bested the 10 other teams by taking home the trophy for best presentation. They researched and developed an archeological experience for families to try out at an actual dig site that raises awareness of the work that archeologists do.
